HISTORY OF THE GOLDEN GATE-SILICON VALLEY INVITATIONAL

The Golden Gate Invitational started in 1997. Duncan Matteson, Chairman for the Matteson Companies, was instrumental in its inception and success. The tournament took place in August at the prestigious Lake Merced Country Club in San Francisco. Since 1997, the tournament has raised more than \$5,300,000 for the American Cancer Society.

The Silicon Valley Invitational started in 2009. Honorary Chairs for the first two years were Greg Jamison (CEO of San Jose Sharks/SVSE) and Bill Murphy (owner, Clos La Chance Wines). Honorary Chairs for 2011 and 2012 event were Rich Braugh (SVP Investments, UBS Financial) and Steve Borkenhagen (Owner, Cafe Stritch). Both Rich and Steve are Rotarians and known well in the SV Community.

In 2016 the two tournaments combined to be now known as the Golden Gate-Silicon Valley Invitational. The event has a good reputation in the community as a first-class golf tournament. The event is successful in event planning committee members and day of volunteers. In the past few years, the event has truly given way to the volunteer driven model and staff supported.

THE GOLF COURSE

This 18-hole golf club is a hidden jewel for golf purists and a wonderful example of what makes the great City of San Francisco so special. In 1922 a group of local visionaries purchased a 140-acre plot of land just a few miles south of the Financial District of San Francisco and made it into what is now-a renowned historic golf course. The championship design has drawn many of the greats of amateur and professional golf to walk its flawless fairways over the past 95 years. The most recent course renovation was contracted to none other than Rees Jones, who is renowned for his ability to awaken Major Championship caliber golf courses.
